SECTION 02100

CLEARING AND GRUBBING

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 DESCRIPTION

The work under this section shall consist of clearing, grubbing, removing and disposing of all vegetation and debris, except such objects as are designated to remain, within the limits of the property. This work shall also include the preservation from injury or defacement of all vegetation and objects designated to remain.

1.2 RELATED SECTIONS

PART 2 - MATERIALS

2.1 HERBICIDE

Herbicides shall be those approved by the USDA for proposed use. Proposed herbicides shall be recommended by the County Extension Agent.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 CLEARING

The area shall be cleared of all surface objects and trees, all stumps, roots and other objectionable obstructions not designated to be retained, resting on, or protruding through the surface of the original ground.

3.2 GRUBBING

The area shall be grubbed of objectionable matter on or projecting through the ground surface. Grubbing shall extend to a depth of at least one foot below the natural ground surface unless:

- A. The area is a structural area as defined in Section 02210 or 02220. In this case, grubbing shall include the removal of all decomposable matter larger than 1 inch in diameter to a depth of 5 feet below the bottom of the structure.
- B. Where fill is placed over 1 foot deep in nonstructural areas. Grubbing may be terminated at the natural ground surface.

Grubbing, except in the case of 3.2.a. above, may be omitted if, in the opinion of the County Extension Agent, the application of the herbicide will produce equivalent results.

3.3 DISPOSAL

All debris generated by the clearing and grubbing operations shall be disposed in a proper manner in accordance with all local, state and federal laws, rules, and regulations.
